Presentation and Evaluation

Guidelines for Critical Dialogue

1. Set Container
2. Suspend judgement
3. Listen
4. Listen with Empathy
5. Authentic Voice
6. Opinions based on observations and experiences
7. Allow diversity
8. Listen without Resistance
9. Respect
10. Balance (Advocacy and Inquiry)

Presentation and Evaluation

Groups present/demonstrate their ideas and design from morning session.

The work is evaluated by others – important to keep points constructive, positive and relevant to the point which is to develop a shared/common understanding.

Key point – there will a variety of approaches to the brief. Creativity and Innovation are important.
