The SEMI-COLON separates the two declarations

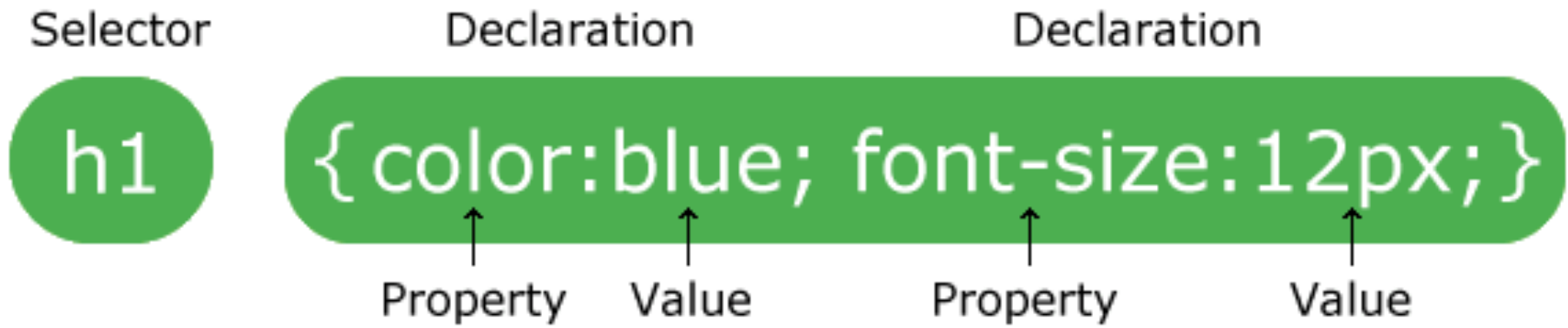
The final SEMI-COLON is not necessary, but good practice

```
div p, #id:first-line {  
    background-color : red ;  
    background-style : none  
}
```
